SALA is a tracking solution for student ad-hoc or unscheduled events, such as a trip to the nurse's office, guidance counselor, etc. The SALA application works directly with a smart ID card and a card reader, allowing users to record student entry and exit to and from ad-hoc locations. A card reader is connected to the user's computer through a USB port. Students simply tap their card on the reader and their whereabouts are recorded. (This works like a digital sign-in sheet.) SALA can be accessed directly from the Management Site. Student's in and out taps are time-stamped and can be viewed in realtime.
